

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Opposing Reorganization of ORD, IHS)

RES. NO. 164-82

1 WHEREAS, on April 19, 1968, the Papago Tribal Council endorsed and
2 accepted a proposal by the Division of Indian Health to establish
3 an independent area-like organization for the Sells Service Unit
4 which included the Santa Rosa and San Xavier Health Centers;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, this organization, called the Office of Research and Development
7 (ORD), has become an integral part of the health delivery program
8 of the Papago Tribe in that it serves and administers all health
9 service functions like an administrative area or service unit
10 office of Indian Health Service; and

11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council accepted ORD on the condition that the Papagos
12 participate in all future program development and be included in
13 planning for health services for the Papago people; and

14 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has learned of the proposed reorganization of
15 ORD by transferring contracting activities to the Phoenix Area
16 Contracting Office; and

17 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has not been consulted about the reorganization
18 of ORD.


19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does not endorse or
20 support this reorganization and does hereby request Dr. Everett
21 Rhoades, Director of Indian Health Services, to consult with the
22 Papago Tribe regarding the existence of the Office of Research
23 and Development and all functions being administered by that
24 office prior to any reorganization.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council requests Dr. Rhoades to
26 meet and consult with the Papago Tribe before any reorganization
27 takes place.


28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Attorneys, and other officers
29 and agents of the Papago Tribe and the Arizona Congressional
30 representatives take all actions necessary to implement the
31 provisions and purposes of this Resolution.

32 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
of December, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1104 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as
amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
