

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Accepting Resignation of Personnel Committee)

RES. NO. 16-82

1 WHEREAS, the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual of the Papago Tribe
2 requires the appointment by the Papago Council of a seven member
3 Personnel Committee consisting of two Council persons, two
4 Department Heads and three employees of the Papago Tribe to advise
5 the Chairman on matters of Personnel Policies, Procedures and
6 problems and to investigate and make determinations and recommenda-
7 tions to the Chairman on employee grievances not resolved within a
8 department; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 07-80 appoint Henry Ramon,
10 William Lewis, Sr., Richard Leon, Mark Lopez, Crystal Ann Smith,
11 Matilda Juan and Roger Antone as members of the Personnel
12 Committee; and

13 WHEREAS, the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual provides that members
14 of the Committee be chosen or reaffirmed annually and the appointed
15 members have acted on the Committee for a period in excess of two
16 years and have tendered their resignation from the Committee.


17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
18 accept the resignation of the members of the Personnel Committee.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
20 day of February, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1060.5 for; 87.5 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
23 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
24 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
25 the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
26 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
27 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
28 enactment by the Papago Council.
