

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Delegating Authority to Personnel Director)  
(to Appoint Grievance Committees )


RES. NO. 17-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has today accepted the resignation of all members  
2 of the Personnel Committee appointed pursuant to Resolution No.  
3 07-80; and  
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does not have sufficient funds to provide the  
5 Personnel Committee with the per diem and mileage expenses required  
6 by the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual ("Manual").  
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, until further order  
8 of this Council, all functions and duties of the Personnel Committee,  
9 except to investigate and make recommendations on employee grievances,  
10 as set out in the Manual are hereby transferred and delegated to the  
11 Personnel Officer, to whom is hereby further delegated authority to  
12 appoint Grievance Committees on an individual ad hoc basis with full  
13 authority to investigate and make recommendations on employee  
14 grievances as provided in Section 3-2 (c) (5) of the Manual, which  
15 Committees shall consist of five (5) members (three (3) of whom  
16 shall constitute a quorum to conduct business by majority vote),  
17 who shall be employees of the Papago Tribe, shall be fair and  
18 impartial, and shall be required to accept appointment thereto by  
19 the Personnel Director unless for good cause excused by the  
20 Chairman.


21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the time limitations set  
22 out in the Manual for the Personnel Committee are hereby extended  
23 as necessary to accomodate the reasonable convenience of the Personnel  
24 Director and the Grievance Committees, and that the Manual is hereby  
25 amended to reflect the intent and purposes of this Resolution.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
27 day of February, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
28 of 892.5 for; 87.5 against; 168.0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
29 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and  
30 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
31 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
32 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
