

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(FY 82 Revenue Sharing Public Hearings)

RES. NO. 28-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did pass Resolution No. 27-82, setting April 16,
2 1982, as the date to hold the FY 82 Revenue Sharing Public Hearing
3 to receive proposals and comments for usage of these monies; and

4 WHEREAS, there were conflicts of other committments on this date; and

5 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee met and proposed to the Tribal
6 Council the following:

7 April 14, 1982 - Wednesday - Public Hearing to receive
8 proposals and comments for Revenue
Sharing monies.

9 April 26 & 27, 1982 - Budget and Finance Committee to review
10 the proposals and comments.

11 May 13, 1982 - Thursday - 2nd Public Hearing. Council
12 to adopt budget for FY 82 Revenue Sharing
monies.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does agree to
14 accept the dates proposed by the Budget and Finance Committee.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd
day of March, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 886.5 for; 124.0 against; 93.5 not voting; and 3 absent,
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
17 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
18 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
19 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
