

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Appointment of Directors of Management)
(Board of Papago Farming Authority)

RES. NO. 30-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 72-79 establish the Papago
2 Farming Authority and adopt a Plan of Operation granting management
3 power to a Management Board of eight persons, five of whom must be
4 members of the Papago Tribe and three of whom must be persons having
5 not less than ten years experience in farming or business management
of substantial character; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolutions No. 121-80 and 63-81, appoint
7 Edward Manuel and Nicklos Jose, two members of the Papago Tribe, and
8 Arthur Pacheco, Jr., a person with at least ten years experience in
the management and operation of agricultural businesses, to a one
year term as directors of the Management Board; and

9 WHEREAS, the term of the foregoing directors has expired, and it is necessary
10 under Section 8C (2) of the Plan of Operation to appoint three board
11 members for terms of three years, two of whom must be members of the
12 Papago Tribe and one of whom must be a person having not less than
13 ten years experience in the management and operation of agricultural
business;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that in accordance with
15 the provisions of Section 8C (2) of the Plan of Operation of the
16 Papago Farming Authority the following persons, meeting the qualifi-
17 cations of Section 8E (1) of the Plan of Operation, are appointed as
directors of the Management Board for a term of three years:

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
21 day of April, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
