


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Funding for San Lucy Health Clinic)

RES. NO. 35-82


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No 47-81 allocate \$17,500.00
2 of Federal Revenue Sharing funds to the San Lucy District; and
3 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District did expend \$13,473.28 of such funds on
4 projects authorized under Papago Council Resolution Nos. 57-81
5 and 163-81; and
6 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has appropriated the balance of
7 \$4,026.72 in Federal Revenue Sharing funds allocated to the San
8 Lucy District, plus the sum of \$973.28 of unappropriated District
9 funds, or a total of \$5,000.00 to help fund the construction and
10 establishment of a permanent health clinic in the District; and
11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the decision of the San Lucy
12 District Council to appropriate such monies for such purposes
13 and approves thereof.
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 approve of the appropriation by the San Lucy District Council of
16 the sum of \$4,026.72, unexpended Federal Revenue Sharing funds
17 previously allocated to the District, and the sum of \$973.28,
18 unappropriated District funds, or of a total of \$5,000.00 to
19 help fund the construction and establishment of a permanent
20 helath clinic in the San Lucy District.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
22 day of April, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
23 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f)
25 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
26 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
27 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Janaury 6, 1937, pursuant to
28 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
29 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
30 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
