

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Supporting PTUA's REA Loan Application)

RES. NO. 36-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Utility Authority ("PTUA") was created by Council  
 2 Resolution No. 08-70 for the purpose of operating and expanding  
 utility services to remote areas of the Papago Reservation; and  
 3 WHEREAS, PTUA has in the past obtained 100 percent financing to expand  
 4 electric facilities and services to many unserved villages from  
 5 the Rural Electrification Administration ("REA"); and  
 6 WHEREAS, there remain a number of unserved villages which will require service  
 7 before a near total coverage of the Papago Reservation can be  
 accomplished; and  
 8 WHEREAS, though PTUA may not qualify for additional 100 percent financing  
 9 under standard REA policies, REA may authorize a 100 percent  
 10 discretionary loan because of the special circumstances existing  
 on the Papago Reservation.  
 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, because of the  
 12 special circumstances existing on the Papago Reservation, it does  
 13 hereby urgently request that the Administrator of REA give favorable  
 14 consideration to PTUA's Discretionary Loan Application necessary to  
 15 complete the electrification of major unserved areas of the Papago  
 Reservation with 100 percent REA financing, preferably at a 2  
 percent interest rate.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
 17 day of April, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
922.0 for; 110.0 against; 116.0 not voting; and 3 absent,  
 18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of  
 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
 19 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
 20 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
 its enactment by the Papago Council.
