

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Hickiwan District - Savings and Loan)

RES. NO. 39-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council approved and adopted the FY '81 Hickiwan
2 District budget on September 4, 1981; and
3 WHEREAS, one of the Line Items under the FY '81 Budget is "Savings
4 and Loan" in the amount of \$5,000.00; and
5 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council has requested the Papago Council
6 to grant approval for the withdrawal of the \$5,000.00 from the
7 Districts IIM Account; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that the Hickiwan District
9 has sufficient guidelines to establish and administer a
10 separate account or accounts for its Savings and Loan
11 Association.
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
13 approve the withdrawal of \$5,000.00 from the Hickiwan District
14 IIM Account in order to establish an FDIC insured account or
15 accounts under the direction and control of the Hickiwan District
16 Savings and Loan Committee.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 19th
18 day of April, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of
21 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
22 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
23 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as
25 of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and
26 is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
