

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Law Enforcement Contract -- Appeal)

RES. NO. 40-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 14-82, did indicate its
2 intention to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant
3 to the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act of
4 1975, P.L. 93-638, for the transfer of all law and order functions;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs
7 may not agree to the transfer of all of said law and order functions;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that the Papago Tribe has under the
10 provisions of the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance
11 Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, the full right and power by contract to
12 assume said law and order functions.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that in the event the
14 Bureau of Indian Affairs should fail to contract for the transfer
15 of all of the law and order functions described in Resolution No.
16 14-82, the Papago Tribe and all of the appropriate officers, agents
17 and attorneys of the Papago Tribe shall institute proper appellate
18 proceedings.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 19th
20 day of April, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (e)
23 and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
24 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
25 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
26 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
27 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
28 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
