

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Establishing San Lucy Cemetary

RES. NO. 46-82

1 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council did on April 28, 1982, by Resolution  
2 No. 27-82, request that a new cemetary be established for its  
3 members and members of the Papago Tribe, on 4.13 acres more or  
4 less, located in the Southeast corner of the Gila Bend Reservation  
5 and more specifically described in the attached site plot and  
6 description; and


7 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District has agreed to undertake the design,  
8 construction and maintenance of the cemetary; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council supports the establishment of a new cemetary  
10 on the San Lucy (Gila Bend) Reservation.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
12 set aside the lands described in the attached site plot and  
13 legal description as a cemetary for members of the San Lucy  
14 District and of the Papago Tribe under the supervision,  
15 management and control of the San Lucy District Council.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th  
17 day of May, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
18 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h) and  
20 Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago  
21 Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,  
1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and  
is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
