

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Treaty Conference

RES. NO. 47-82


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did pass on March 10, 1982, Ordinance No. 03-82,  
2 requiring a permit for certain meetings on the Papago Reservation;  
3 and  
4 WHEREAS, the local representative of the International Indian Treaty Council  
5 did approach the Gu Achi District for approval of such a conference  
6 in the Gu Achi District; and  
7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did receive a letter from the Gu Achi District  
8 Chairman dated 04/10/82, informing them of the District's approval  
9 on 03/23/82, to allow the International Indian Treaty Council to  
10 hold their 8th Annual Conference in their District.  
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby support  
12 the Gu Achi District Council in allowing the 8th Annual Inter-  
13 national Indian Treaty Conference to be held in the Gu Achi District.  
14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council requests that officers,  
15 agents and employees of the Papago Tribe and of Federal agencies  
16 having jurisdiction within the Papago Reservation, including but  
17 not limited to the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the United States  
18 Immigration and Custom Services, are hereby directed or requested  
19 to aid in the prevention of any violation of law by officers,  
20 members, or invitees of the International Indian Treaty Council.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th  
22 day of May, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
23 856.0 for; 265.0 against; 27.0 not voting; and 3 absent,  
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
25 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
26 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
27 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
28 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
29 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
30 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
