1	WHEREAS,	the Community Health Representatives (CHR) Program has provided					
2		cost-effective outreach and community health delivery services					
3		to the Papago Tribe, making optimum use of existing Indian Health					
4		Service facilities and being based upon local needs and					
5		priorities; and					
6	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service has cut the CHR Program by 21% in fiscal					
7		year 1982, and proposes to eliminate it entirely in fiscal year					
8		1983; and					
9	WHEREAS,	such cuts in, or proposed elimination of the CHR Program will					
10		require that elderly people presently receiving home health care					
11		be institutionalized; will result in longer hospital stays					
12		because of lack of hospital discharge follow-up services; will					
13		result in untreated pregnancy complications and childhood					
14		diseases because of lack of maternal and child health services;					
15		may result in renal shutdown for as many as 17 dialysis patients					
16		because of lack of transportation; and will generally have a					
17		devasting effect upon the people served by the Program; and					
18	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council believes that existing cuts in, or the					
19		elimination of the CHR Program are counterproductive to cost					
20		efficient health delivery on the Papago Reservation.					
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby						
22		fully support the Community Health Representatives Program of					
23		the Papago Tribe as developed and funded through fiscal year 1981.					
24	BE IT FU	RTHER RESOLVED that it does hereby urgently request Congress to					
25		fund the Community Health Representative line item of the Indian					
26		Health Service budget in fiscal year 1983 at the fiscal year					
27		1981 level.					
28	BE IT FU	RIHER RESOLVED that it does hereby authorize and direct the officers					
29		of the Papago Tribe and of the Executive Health Staff to prepare					
30		reports showing the impact of existing cuts in, or the elimination					
31		of the CHR Program on the Papago Tribe for submission to Congress,					
32		and they are hereby directed to take such steps and to do all

things which are necessary or appropriate to effectuate the

purposes of this Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th day of May, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
