7 used as follows:



12 the FY 1982 Revenue Sharing funds to be expended as follows:



21 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


