RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Well Maintenance Rates for Services

RES. NO. 60-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did, by Resolution No. 105-81, adopt the FY'82
2 budget of the Well Maintenance Department, "Department", for
3 \$88,500.00 to cover salaries, insurance, and operation/maintenance;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Department's budget does not cover additional services that
6 may be requested by individuals, districts and/or outside
7 agencies; and

8 WHEREAS, the Department has submitted the following schedule of rates for
9 services which are subject to modification:

10 RATE CHARGES ON WELL RIGS:

11 10 Ton Rig, \$50./hour w/3 or 4 men crew, 20¢/mile
12 12 Ton Rig, \$50./hour w/3 or 4 men crew, 20¢/mile
13 30 Ton Rig, \$50./hour w/3 or 4 men crew, 20¢/mile

14 BACKHOE RENTAL:

15 \$35./hour - 3 hour minimum, use own fuel, oil, etc.
16 \$15./hour - Service Charges w/Operator

17 Oxygen and Acetylene not for loan or rent

18 CUTTING AND WELDING:

19 \$15./hour - 1 hour minimum, \$15./hour after first hour

20 ARC WELDING:

21 \$25./hour - 1 hour minimum, \$15./hour after first hour

22 **WATER HAULING:

23 \$80./load, 20¢/mile service charge

24 **SEPTIC PUMP OUT:

25 \$35./load

26 SANITARY LANDFILLS:

27 (See Backhoe Rental Charges)

28 ** = Charging Already

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize
30 the Department to charge individuals, districts, and/or outside
31 agencies for costs of labor, parts, rental of equipment and mileage
32 rates for services rendered.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby direct the
Treasurer to establish a separate account into which to deposit
these monies collected, and keep the Department informed of

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve the


above-mentioned schedule of rates which are subject to modification.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 359.0 for; 526.0 against; 263.0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
