

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Regulating Attendance at Council Meetings

RES. NO. 61-82


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is under the Papago Constitution empowered to
2 regulate its own procedures and, as the governing body of the Papago
3 Tribe, has inherent authority to regulate the conduct of its members
4 attending Council Meetings.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that representatives to
6 the Council, or their alternates, attending meetings of the Council
7 shall be present or available at each Council Meeting from the time
8 such meeting is called to order until it is adjourned, unless they
9 have been excused by the person chairing the meeting.


10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that representatives, or their alternates, may be
11 excused from Council Meetings only upon a showing of personal,
12 business or family emergency, and that any representative or
13 alternate who attends a meeting of the Council but who absents
14 himself or herself from such meeting without being excused by the
15 person chairing the meeting or by the Council shall forfeit his or
16 her right to compensation for attending such meeting.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
18 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 728.0 for; 254.5 against; 165.5 not voting; and 0 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of
21 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
22 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
23 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
25 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
26 its enactment by the Papago Council.
