

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Tabling Pisinemo District Resolution)


RES. No. 63-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does have authority to approve/disapprove
2 Districts' expenditures of any and all monies allocated; and
3 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council approved the attached resolution
4 allocating \$20,000.00 each to four villages (Pisinemo, San Simon,
5 Santa Cruz, and Kupk/Dirtburn) for village projects; and
6 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo Village was the only one to submit a budget which
7 amount exceeded the allocation of \$20,000.00 to \$29,000.00; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is requesting written approval of the District
9 Council for the additional \$9,000 and budgets from the other
10 villages.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that no further action
12 concerning the District's budget will be taken until the Pisinemo
13 District Council submits written approval of the additional \$9,000
14 and all villages in the District have submitted their budgets.


15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
16 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 504.0 for; 197.5 against; 446.5 not voting; and 1 absent,
18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
19 Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
20 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
21 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
22 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject
23 to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
24 its enactment by the Papago Council.
