

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Approving Amendments to Baboquivari District FY'82 Budget

RES. NO. 64-82

1 WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District did on June 3, 1982, approve a resolution
2 authorizing the transfer of funds budgeted but unused in FY 1981
3 to the District's FY 1982 budget as follows:

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the action of the District Council
9 and approves thereof.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
11 approve of the transfer of funds budgeted but unused in the
12 District's FY 1981 budget to its FY 1982 budget, and authorizes
13 expenditures from the District's IIM account by or for the benefit
14 of the foregoing villages in accordance with the village budgets
15 duly approved by their respective Councils.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
17 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 671.5 for; 170.0 against; 306.5 not voting; and 1 absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of
20 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
21 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
22 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
23 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
24 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
25 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
