

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Approving Gu Achi District Budget FY 1982

RES. NO. 65-82

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council did on June 2, 1982, adopt an amended  
2 budget covering a period of 16 months, June 1, 1982 through September  
3 30, 1983, in the amount of \$211,007.11, a copy of which is attached  
4 hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

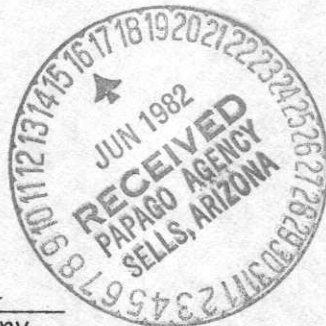
5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the budget; has determined that  
6 there are sufficient funds in the District's IIM account to cover  
7 the budget; and has approved the budget.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
9 approve the attached budget of the Gu Achi District Council for the  
10 period of June 1, 1982 through September 30, 1983, and authorizes  
11 the expenditure of funds from the District IIM account in accordance  
12 therewith.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th  
14 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
15 1104.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
16 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of  
17 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
18 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
19 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
20 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date  
21 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to  
22 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
