

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Approving San Lucy District Revenue Sharing Budget)

RES. NO. 70-82

1 Whereas, the Papago Council did by Resloution No. 54-82, appropriate the  
2 sum of \$11,642.45 of FY 82 Federal Revenue Sharing funds to the San  
3 Lucy District to be expended in accordance with the qualifying prior-  
4 ities expressed at the Public Hearings conducted for such pruposes;  
5 and

6 Whereas, the San Lucy District Council did meet on May 19, 1982, and re-  
7 viewed the District's needs as expressed at such public hearings and  
8 by Resolution No.29-82, allocated the funds which were appropriated  
9 to the District as follows: \$10,075.75 - Clinic Bldg. Project

600.00 - Medicines

716.00 - Early Childhood Coord.

250.00 - Youth Activities

\$11,642.45

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the District's allocation of such  
13 funds and approved of same; and

14 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has heard a suggestion from the San Lucy Dist-  
15 rict Council that Federal Revenue Sharing funds draw interest while  
16 on deposit.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
18 approve of the foregoing allocation by the San Lucy District Council  
19 of the sum of \$11,642.45 of Federal Revenue Sharing funds appropri-  
20 ated to the San Lucy District pursuant to Papago Council Resolution  
21 No. 54-82.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Revenue Sharing Coordinator and the Treasurer  
23 of the Papago Tribe arrange that interest will accure on the Federal  
24 Revenue Sharing funds which the Papago Tribe has on deposit with  
25 the bank.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the  
28 11 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present  
29 with a vote of 819 for; 0 against; 329.0 not voting; and  
30 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by  
31 Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December  
12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is  
effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
