

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Authorizing the PSUIHAB Contract

RES. NO. 71-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council recognizes its right to address the health  
2 needs of its members as identified below in the way it chooses  
3 to do so pursuant to P.L. 93-638, the Indian Self-Determination  
4 Act; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that said health services can best  
6 be provided to its members living on the Gila Bend Reservation  
7 and outside the Sells and San Xavier Reservations by working  
8 together with other tribes and tribal organizations; as provided  
9 for in P.L. 93-638; and

10 WHEREAS, the Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Advisory Board, Inc.,  
11 (PSUIHAB) is a legally established non-profit organization, whose  
12 governing body is composed of tribal representatives and includes  
13 the maximum participation of Indian people in all phases of  
14 its activity; and

15 WHEREAS, the Papago Council wishes to establish the eligibility of the  
16 PSUIHAB, Inc., to contract with the Indian Health Service (IHS)  
17 on its behalf, consistent with tribal resolution requirement for  
18 initial contracts as set out in the regulations promulgated under  
19 P.L. 93-638, which are found in 42 CFR 36:206.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

- 21 1. The Papago Council designates the PSUIHAB, Inc., as the tribal  
22 organization within the meaning of the Indian Self-Determination  
23 and Education Assistance Act (P.L. 93-638) for the purposes  
24 set out below.
- 25 2. The Papago Council authorizes the PSUIHAB, Inc., to apply  
26 for, negotiate, and enter into a P.L. 93-638 contract with  
27 the Indian Health Service (IHS) subject only to the specific  
28 terms, conditions, and limitations of this resolution and  
29 applicable tribal laws, codes, regulations, and customs of  
30 the Papago Tribe.




3. The scope of said P.L. 93-638 contract shall include:
  - a. Responsibility for administering Housekeeping services at the Phoenix Indian Medical Center;
  - b. Responsibility for administering Dietary services at the Phoenix Indian Medical Center;
  - c. Responsibility for administering Maintenance services at the Phoenix Indian Medical Center.
4. Final approval of the Papago Council to the terms of said contract shall be through the consent of the Tribe's representative on the PSUIHAB, Inc., Board of Directors.
5. Copies of documents and correspondence relating to said contract shall be sent to the Papago Tribe, c/o Alton Wallace, Chairman, Executive Health Staff, P. O. Box 837, Sells, Arizona 85634.
6. The terms of said P.L. 93-638 contract with PSUIHAB Inc., for FY 1982 shall be from October 1, 1981 to September 30, 1982.
7. Other than those specifically outlined above, there are no limitations on the authority granted to PSUIHAB, Inc., relating to said contract.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 908.5 for; 200.0 against; 39.5 not voting; and 0 absent; pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
