

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Amending General Counsel Contract)

RES. NO. 73-82

1 WHEREAS, the law firm of Strickland & Altaffer was by General Counsel
2 Contract (Symbol H50C1420-Contract Number 2421) employed as
3 general counsel to represent the Papago Tribe for a period of
4 two years, effective September 25, 1981, through September 24, 1983;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, at the time said contract was executed neither the Tribe nor its
7 general counsel could accurately anticipate the amount of time
8 which would be required to represent the Tribe and an annual
9 limitation of \$153,700.00 was placed upon fees and expenses to
10 be incurred under the contract; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tribe's general counsel have rendered services to the Tribe
12 in excess of the number of hours originally estimated and it is
13 anticipated that substantially more services will be required in
14 the future.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the \$153,700.00
16 limitation on legal fees and expenses set in the General Counsel
17 Contract with the law firm of Strickland & Altaffer be increased
18 to \$228,700.00, and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Papago
19 Council are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached
20 Amendment to the General Counsel Contract for and on behalf of the
21 Papago Tribe.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget of the Papago Tribe be and it is
23 hereby amended in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No.
24 08-82 to reflect the increase in legal fees and expenses contem-
25 plated by the attached Amendment to General Counsel Contract.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th
27 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
28 504.5 for; 410.5 against; 233.0 not voting; and 0 absent,
29 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b) and
30 Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the
31 Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,
32 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
