

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Contracting of Employment Assistance

RES. NO. 77-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has determined that vocational training
2 is needed on the Papago Reservation; and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council established the Papago Skill Center
4 by Resolution No. 04-79, to help achieve on-reservation training
5 sites; and

6 WHEREAS, P. L. 93-638 CFR, Part 271 has provided the tribe with the
7 mechanism to contract Bureau operated programs.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it does hereby authorize the Papago
9 Tribe to enter into a multi-year contract with the Bureau of
10 Indian Affairs pursuant to CFR 271 for the Employment Assistance
11 Program. Contract period beginning October 1, 1982 through
12 September 30, 1985.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs provide the Papago
14 Tribe with any and all technical assistance necessary in the
15 preparation of the contract.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, Enos J. Francisco, Jr.,
17 Vice Chairman and Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are
18 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any
19 amendments thereto on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th
21 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d)
24 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
