

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
P. L. 93-638 Contracts FY 1983

RES. NO. 81-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following  
2 programs under FY 1982 P. L. 93-638 contracts with the Bureau  
3 of Indian Affairs:

4 Papago Children's Home  
5 Papago Agricultural Services  
6 Papago Children's Court  
7 Papago Adult Court  
8 Papago Enrollment  
9 Papago JOM Education  
10 Papago Rehabilitation Center  
11 Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEP)  
12 Papago Community Education  
13 Papago Early Childhood Education

14 WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to  
15 the Papago Tribe and its people; and

16 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all  
17 proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the  
18 Tribal Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the  
19 contract termination; and

20 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for provision  
21 of these services during FY 1983.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize  
23 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the  
24 Papago Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the  
25 provision of services titled:

26 Papago Children's Home  
27 Papago Agricultural Services  
28 Papago Children's Court  
29 Papago Adult Court  
30 Papago Enrollment  
31 Papago JOM Education  
32 Papago Rehabilitation Center  
Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEP)  
Papago Community Education  
Papago Early Childhood Education

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall be from  
October 1, 1982 through September 30, 1983.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate  
2 programs for which contracts are requested herewith which have  
3 not been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
4 prior to the start of the funding year.


5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the contracts are not executed by the  
6 Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to October 1, 1982, the Papago  
7 Tribal Council will request the Arizona Congressional delegation  
8 for an oversight hearing of the Phoenix Area Office.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby requests to  
10 have all contract negotiations conducted at the Tribal Offices  
11 in Sells, Arizona.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, Enos J. Francisco, Jr.,  
13 Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council, is  
14 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and  
15 any amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th  
17 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
18 1063.0 for; 0 against; 85.0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
20 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
21 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
22 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
23 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
24 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
25 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
