

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

P. L. 93-638 Grants FY 1983

RES. NO. 82-82

1 WHEREAS, Section 104(a) of P. L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of
2 funds for the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of Tribal
3 Government"; and

4 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$272,800.00 of FY 1983
5 funds for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and


6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its
7 Tribal government and management.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the
9 amount of at least \$272,800.00 for FY 1983 to be budgeted as
10 reviewed and approved by the Tribal Council. Any remaining
11 balance of grant funds will be budgeted for indirect cost.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, Enos J. Francisco, Jr.,
13 Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized to
14 negotiate and sign whatever grant documents are required and,
15 further, to negotiate and sign amendments and extensions to
16 such grant.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th
18 day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 957.0 for; 124.5 against; 66.5 not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d)
21 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
22 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
23 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
24 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
25 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
26 by the Papago Council.
