RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Approving Bill for Use and Distribution of Judgment Funds

1	WHEREAS,	the Indian Claims Commission did on July 21, 1976, enter a final
2		award of \$26,000,000.00 to the Papago Tribe in settlement of the
3		Papago Tribe's land and trespass claims involving some 6.3 million
		acres of land, asserted in Docket 395, and a claim for general
4		accounting, asserted in Docket 102; and
5	WHEREAS,	funds to satisfy the award were appropriated by the Act of
6		September 30, 1976, Public Law 94-438, 90. Stat. 1416, and were
7		invested by the Secretary of Interior ("Secretary") pursuant to
	MHEDEVC	25 U.S.C. 162 (a) and 25 C.F.R. 60.11; and the Secretary is required under the provisions of Public Law 93-134,
8	WILKLAS,	87 Stat. 468, 25 U.S.C. 1401, and 25 C.F.R., Part 60, to develop a
9		plan for the use and distribution of these funds; and
10	WHEREAS.	the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 08-81, refer all recommend-
		ations, resolutions and communications developed by, or referred to
11		the Papago Council and the Tribe from all tribal members and legal
12		entities entitled to share in the funds including a committee of
13		District Chairmen established by the Papago Council, and the
14		various Districts, to the Secretary with the request that he develop
	1,000	such a plan and hold public hearings of record thereon; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Secretary did develop a proposed Secretarial Plan which provides
16		for the per capita distribution of fifty per cent of the funds on
17		hand, and for the investment, reinvestment and use of the remaining
18		fifty percent for tribal programs; and
	WHEREAS,	the Secretary did conduct public hearings within the Papago
19		Reservation on the plan, which received substantial support from
20	MUEDEAC	members of the Papago Tribe; and
21	WHEREAS,	the time permitted for the development of a Secretarial plan under Public Law 93-134 has long ago expired and it will be necessary to
22		submit any plan for the distribution of judgment funds to Congress
		for enactment into law; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council is seriously concerned about the Secretary's
24		delays in furnishing such plan; about the drastic cuts in tribal
25		programs resulting from reductions in federal supports for Indian
26		programs; about the likelihood of serious cuts in or termination of
		tribal mining revenues; and about the economic plight of members of
27		the Papago Tribe, and believes that it is essential forthwith to
28		proceed with a judgment distribution plan which will make funds
29		immediately available both for tribal programs and for partial per
30		capita distributions to qualifying members of the Papago Tribe
		whose applications for membership have been approved in accordance
31		with the provisions of the Papago Enrollment Ordinance, Ordinance
32		No. 05-81, and the Papago Enrollment Manual; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary presently has on hand in excess of \$ in funds subject to distribution to the Papago Tribe and its members, and the Papago Council estimates that there will be fewer than 16,000 persons who will qualify for per capita distribution of such funds; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the attached proposed Bill to provide for the use and distribution of the Papago Tribe's judgment funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve of the provisions of the attached Bill which provide for the use and distribution of the Papago Tribe of Arizona judgment funds in Dockets 345 and 102, before the Indian Claims Commission, and does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman, attorneys, lobbyists and other appropriate officers of the Papago Tribe to do everything necessary and appropriate to have the substantative provisions thereof enacted into law at the earliest possible moment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby requests the help of the Secretary and Department of Interior and of the Arizona delegation to Congress to do everything within their power to assure the prompt passage of the substantive provisions of the attached Bill into law.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 24th day of June, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1004.0 for; 144.0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
