

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
IMPL Funds/Santa Rosa Boarding and Day School

RES. NO. 88-82

1 WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa Boarding and Day School Board has requested
2 \$60,000.00 of tribal IMPL funds as a one time start up fund to
3 start the school's ninth grade as directed by Council Resolution
4 No. 44-82; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that the Papago Agency has
6 identified in excess of \$111,000.00 of the Agency's IMPL funds
7 as belonging to, and being subject to appropriation by the
8 Papago Tribe.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 appropriate \$60,000.00 of funds in the Papago Agency's IMPL
11 accounts and which have been identified by the Agency as
12 belonging to the Papago Tribe to the Santa Rosa Boarding and
13 Day School to be expended pursuant to the attached budget.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
15 day of July, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 898.5 for; 0 against; 328.5 not voting; and 0 absent,
17 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
18 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
19 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
20 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
21 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
22 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
23 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
