

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

New Bureau High School Construction

RES. NO. 89-82

1 WHEREAS, it has long been the desire of the Papago Tribe that all children
2 on the Papago Reservation be given the opportunity of attending
3 schools near their communities; and

4 WHEREAS, it has been documented that the lack of this opportunity has had
5 a damaging effect on the Papago people; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has thoroughly documented the need for a new
7 high school on the Reservation; and

8 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs study 'A Day School Opportunity For
9 All Indian Children', December, 1981, has supported the need for
10 a high school on the Papago Reservation; and


11 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is seriously pursuing the closure of
12 off-reservation boarding schools, an action that would displace
13 over 500 Papago high school students.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the School Facilities
16 and Construction Office begin immediate steps to:


- 17 1) Begin a planning and design phase for construction
18 of a new Bureau operated high school.
19 2) Seek adequate appropriations for the construction
20 of a new Bureau operated high school on the Papago
21 Reservation.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
23 day of August, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
25 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) and
26 (k) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
27 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
28 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
29 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
30 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
31 enactment by the Papago Council.
