

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

1982 - O.E.D.P. Report

RES. NO. 92-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council at its December 1, 1972, meeting established
2 an Overall Economic Development Committee, expanded by Resolution
3 No. 39-76, later further expanded by Resolution No. 105-80; and

4 WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Development Administration, Department of
5 Commerce, requires its recipient agencies to submit an annual
6 status report of any past, present and future projects; and

7 WHEREAS, the O.E.D.P. Committee has not been active for the past year
8 whose duty included preparation of such a report; and


9 WHEREAS, the Tribal Office of Economic Development Planning has prepared
10 the required report for submission; and

11 WHEREAS, the subject report further requires the approval of the Papago
12 Council.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve
14 the Papago Tribe's Overall Economic Development Plan for 1982 to
15 be submitted to the Office of Economic Development Administration,
16 Department of Commerce.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
18 day of August, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1121.0 for; 0 against; 27.0 not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
21 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
enactment by the Papago Council.
