

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Amending Plan of Operation/Papago Farms Authority

RES. NO. 93-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolutions No. 91-79 and 04-81, amend  
2 the Plan of Operation of the Papago Farming Authority ("Authority")  
3 authorizing the Authority to obligate itself in an amount not to  
4 exceed the sum of \$1,000,000.00 in the aggregate in order to  
5 finance crops on the Authority's farms; and

6 WHEREAS, the planted acreage of the Authority, both at the Papago and Vaiva  
7 Vo Farms, has increased and it is necessary for the Authority to  
8 obtain larger crop loans to finance crops on all of the acreage  
9 under its jurisdiction; and


10 WHEREAS, the Management Board of the Authority has requested the Papago  
11 Council for authority to obligate the Authority in an amount not  
12 to exceed the sum of \$1,500,000.00 in the aggregate in order to  
13 finance crops on the Authority's farms.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that paragraph 8 of  
15 Section 6 B of the Plan of Operation of the Papago Farming  
16 Authority be amended to read as follows:

17 8. "To execute guaranties. To make any guaranty respecting  
18 indebtedness, interest, contracts or other obligations  
19 lawfully entered into by or on behalf of the Authority,  
20 to the extent that such guaranty is made in pursuance  
21 of the purposes set forth in Section 4 of this title,  
22 provided that no such guaranty in excess of Two Hundred  
Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be made  
without the prior written approval of the Papago Council,  
unless such guaranty is for the purpose of securing crop  
loans, in which event such guaranty, and the aggregate  
of other guaranties, shall not be in excess of \$1,500,000."


23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
24 day of August, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
25 of 849.5 for; 0 against; 298.5 not voting; and 2 absent,  
26 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and  
27 Section 3 (g) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December  
12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is  
effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
