

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Authorizing Baboquivari District to
Establish Separate Projects Accounts

RES. NO. 01-84

1 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 18 of the Papago Tribe ordains that all District
2 funds be deposited and kept in Papago Agency Individual Indian
3 Money (IIM) Accounts; and

4 WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council has requested authority from
5 the Papago Council to establish and maintain separate District
6 checking account for funds appropriated by the District for
7 projects within the District which will require the signatures
8 of two of the following: the District Projects Manager, the
9 District Council Treasurer or the District Secretary; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council concurs with the request of the Baboquivari
11 District Council.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Baboquivari
13 District Council is hereby authorized to transfer funds on
14 deposit in the District's IIM accounts which have been duly
15 appropriated by the District for District projects into a
16 separate checking account with First Interstate Bank, Southgate
17 Branch, which will require the signatures of two of the following
18 District officers upon any withdrawals; the District Projects
19 Manager, the District Council Treasurer or the District Secretary.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
21 day of January, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1302.0 for; 138.0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
24 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
25 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
26 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
27 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
28 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
29 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
