	appropriated by the District for District projects into a						
12	separate checking account with First Interstate Bank, Southgate						
13	Branch, which will require the signatures of two of the following						
14	District officers upon any withdrawals; the District Projects						
15	Manager, the District Council Treasurer or the District Secretary.

16	of <u>1302.0</u> for; <u>138.0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting; and <u>0</u> absent,						
17	pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona						
18	as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
