

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Approving Letting of '638 Contract to
Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Board

RES. NO. 05-84

1 WHEREAS, the Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Board, Inc., ("PSUIHB, Inc.")
2 has proposed a P. L. 93-638 contract with the Indian Health
3 Service (IHS) for programs providing the following services
4 during the 1984 fiscal year for benefit of its members, including
5 members of the Papago Tribe residing in the San Lucy District,
6 to-wit:


- 7 a) Administrative Services for the contract
- 8 b) Community Health Representative Program at
9 the Yavapai-Prescott Indian Community
- 10 c) Patient Representative Program
- 11 d) Tuberculosis Control Program
- 12 e) Resource Development for Home Health Care Program
- 13 f) Eyeglass Program
- 14 g) Orthodontic Program
- 15 h) National Health Service Corp. Dental Project
16 Gila Crossing
- 17 i) Guiding Star Lodge
- 18 j) Substance Abuse; and

19 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has by Resolution No. 08-83,
20 approved and has recommended that the Papago Council in turn
21 approve the letting of such contract by the IHS to the PSUIHB, Inc.


22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
23 approve the letting by the IHS of a P. L. 93-638 contract to the
24 Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Board, Inc., for the foregoing
25 programs for fiscal year 1984.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
27 day of January, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
28 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
29 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
30 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
31 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
32 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
enactment by the Papago Council.
