

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Base Roll Additions

RES. NO. 07-84

1 WHEREAS, Section 1 (a) of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago
2 Tribe as amended, provides that the Papago Council can make
3 additions and changes to the official census rolls of the
4 Sells and Gila Bend Reservations dated January 1, 1937, and of
5 the San Xavier Reservation dated January 1, 1940, subject to
6 the approval of the Secretary of the Interior; and

7 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has determined that the following
8 named persons were members of the Papago Tribe on the date of
9 the respective census rolls but that their names had been
10 inadvertently omitted therefrom, and has recommended that
11 their names be added to the rolls; and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendations of the
13 Enrollment Committee and approves thereof.

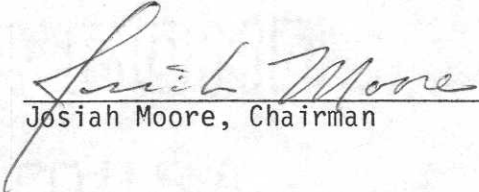
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, subject to
15 the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, the names of
16 the following persons be added to the official census rolls
17 of the Sells, Gila Bend or San Xavier Reservation, to wit:

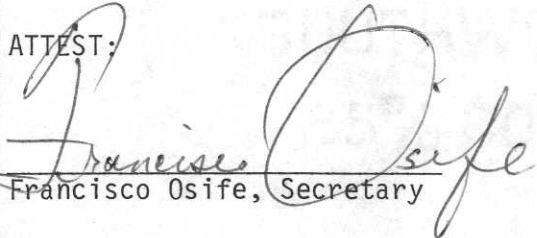
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the required approval be secured from the
19 Secretary of the Interior before their names be formally
20 added to such rolls.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
22 day of January, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
23 of 1333.0 for; 0 against; 107.0 not voting; and 0 absent,
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 1 (a) of
25 Article II and Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of
26 the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on
27 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January
28 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
29 Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior
30 and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
