1	WHEREAS,	the Sells Papago Reservation was originally established by execu-
2		tive order issued by the President on February 01, 1917; and
3	WHEREAS,	the Papago Tribe has continuously since time immemorial, utilized,
		occupied, resided on and claimed those certain lands legally
4		described as Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31, Township 18 South,
5	MUEDEAS	Range 3 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian; and pursuant to the Act of July 28, 1937 (30 Stat. 536), an area of
6	WILKERS,	land was added to the Gu Vo District of the Sells Papago Reserva-
7		tion which included all of fractional Townships 18 and 19 South,
8		Range 3 West, except Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31 in Township
		28 South, Range 3 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian; and
9	WHEREAS,	original consideration was given by the Federal Government to
10		include all of Townships 18 and 19 South, Range 3 West as part of
11		the Gu Vo District of the Sells Papago Reservation, but on the
12		basis of an informal request of the National Park Service, with-
13		out any notice or imput from the Papago Tribe, Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31 were eliminated for the reason that said lands were
		then proposed to be included within the Organ Pipe National
14		Monument; and
15	WHEREAS,	since time immemorial, the members of the Papago Tribe have been
16		and still are grazing their cattle in this area, originally on
17		the basis that they considered this area as Papago Land and since
18		July 28, 1937, under a Special Use Permit; and
	WHEREAS,	Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31 in Township 18 South, Range 3
19		West, Gila and Salt River Meridian is isolated from the main area
20		of the Organ Pipe National Monument by reason of the crest of the Ajo Mountains and therefore serves little or no purpose, recrea-
21		tionally or otherwise to the public, but does require additional
22		Federal expense to patrol and maintain; and
23	WHEREAS,	changing the status of this area to Papago Reservation land as
		part of the Gu Vo District would not change the use of the land,
24		endanger the natural habitat or the environmental condition of
25		the land; and
26	WHEREAS,	it would be in the best interest of the Gu Vo District, the Papago Tribe and the United States Government if this area were, by
27		legislative action, made part of the Gu Vo District of the Sells
28		Papago Reservation.
29	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it hereby
		authorizes the Chairman and other tribal and district officers,
30		attorneys and district advisors to take all necessary steps to
31		acquire federal legislation changing the legal status of Sections
32		6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31 located in Township 18 South, Range 3
