

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Sif Oidak  
(District Facilities Relocation)


1 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council did propose to apply for Community  
2 Development Block Grant Program funds in order to rebuild and re-  
3 locate certain district buildings and facilities which are located in  
4 Chuichu and were damaged in the October 1983 floods; and  
5 WHEREAS, the District Council did solicit the views and participation of its  
6 people in developing the proposal to apply for such funds, following  
7 traditional means of citizen involvement, including two publicized  
8 public hearings in which they were provided with information concerning  
9 the proposed source and use of the funds and an opportunity to express  
10 their preferences and to select priorities for the use of the funds; and  
11 WHEREAS, upon review of, and in accordance with the comments and views expressed  
12 to the Sif Oidak Council, the Council determined to apply for Community  
13 Development Block Grant program funds for the purpose of such facili-  
14 ties relocation and, by Resolution No. 11-84 requested that the Papago  
15 Council support, approved and authorize, the Sif Oidak Council to  
16 apply for such funds.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby supports,  
14 approves and authorizes the Sif Oidak Council to apply for Community  
15 Development Block Grant program funds to reconstruct and relocate  
16 damaged district facilities and buildings;


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs and  
17 authorizes any and all appropriate officials to consult with and  
18 negotiate for Community Development Block Grant funding and to  
19 execute any and all contracts and legal documents and any amendments  
20 thereto which may be necessary to implement the project.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd  
21 day of May, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
22 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent,  
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), and (d)  
24 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
26 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
27 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by  
28 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment  
29 by the Papago Council.
