## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Additions to the Official Base Roll)

Res. No. 103-84

WHEREAS, Section 1 (a) of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe 1 as amended, provides that the Papago Council can make additions and 2 changes to the official census rolls of the Sells and Gila Bend 3 Reservations dated January 1, 1937, and of the San Xavier Reservation 4 dated January 1, 1940, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior; and 5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has determined that the following named 6 persons were members of the Papago Tribe on the date of the respective 7 census rolls but that their names had been inadvertently omitted there from, and has recommended that their names be added to the rolls; and 8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendations of the Enrollment 9 Committee and approves thereof. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, and names of the following 11 persons be added to the official census rolls of the Sells, Gila Bend 12 or San Xavier Reservation, to wit; 13 1527-B-75 KIRMAN, Jose 674-P-74 ANTONE, Martha 1414-CK-83 GARCIA, Julio E. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the required approval be secured from the 20 Secretary of the Interior before their names be formally added to such 21 rolls. 22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 31st day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1386.5 for; -O- against; 53.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Article V, Section 2 24 (f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-25 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
