

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Approval of Submission of Application for  
Community Development Block Grant  
for Nursing Home)



1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has submitted an application for a grant to fund  
2 certain eligible Indian Community Development Block Grant Program  
3 activities and in connection with such application resolve and made  
4 certain assurances.


4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that prior to the submission of its application,  
5 the governing body of the applicant has: Provided Tribal citizens,  
6 especially those living in areas where activities are proposed or  
7 ongoing, with adequate information concerning the amount of funds  
8 available for proposed community development and housing activities,  
9 the range of activities that may be assisted, and other important  
10 program requirements, and solicited their views and participation;  
11 followed traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement that included  
12 holding at least one adequately publicized meeting of the Tribal  
13 Council at a time and location convenient to Tribal citizens which  
14 provided them with adequate opportunity to articulate needs, express  
15 preferences about proposed community development and housing  
16 activities, assist in the selection of priorities and otherwise  
17 participate in the development of the application; considered any  
18 comments or views expressed by Tribal members and has modified the  
19 application accordingly; made the modified application available to  
20 Tribal members for review and comments.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 31st  
18 day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
19 1379.5 for; -0- against; 60.5 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to  
20 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article  
21 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
22 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
23 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
24 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
25 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
26 enactment by the Papago Council.
