	WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed provision concerning
4	tribal members and the political power and finds the amendments
5	to be appropriate for inclusion into the proposed Constitution.
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
7	accept and approve of the proposed amendment reading as follows: "All political power is inherent in the people The government of this
8	Nation derives its powers from the consent of the governed and

9	shall not deny to any member of this Nation the equal protection
10	of its laws or deprive any member of the liberty or property with

15	Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not
16	sujbect to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
