

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Addition of Section 3 to Article II Membership of the Proposed  
Constitution

Res. No. 110-84


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes that the Papago Tribe as a government  
2 must exercise its powers of government in such a way not to interfere  
3 or infringe on the rights of its members; and  
4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed provision concerning  
5 tribal members and the political power and finds the amendments  
6 to be appropriate for inclusion into the proposed Constitution.  
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
8 accept and approve of the proposed amendment reading as follows:  
9 "All political power is inherent in the people The government of this  
10 Nation derives its powers from the consent of the governed and  
11 it established to protect and maintain there individual rights it  
shall not deny to any member of this Nation the equal protection  
of its laws or deprive any member of the liberty or property with  
out due process of law.

12 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
13 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
14 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent,  
15 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of  
16 Article V and Article IX of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tirbe on December 12, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not  
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the  
date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
