RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL Accepting the Amendment of Section 1 of Article III Rights of Members as recommended by the Constitution Committee Res. No. 112-84 1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been presented with the final draft of the 2 proposed constitution; and WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed each proposed provision with comments 3 and explanations being made by the Constitution Committee; and 4 WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee has prepared certain alternative provisions for consideration by the Papago Council; and 5 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the alternative provision concerning 6 loss of membership under certain conditions and finds the same to be 7 appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 8 accept the alternative provision proposed by the Constitution 9 Committee providing the: Membership in this Nation and all rights 10 deriving therefrom shall be lost if a person is convicted of the criminal offenses of murder or voluntary manslaughter by any court 11 of competent jurisdiction. 12 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th day of <u>June</u>, <u>1984</u>, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1440.0</u> for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>-0-</u> not voting; and <u>-0-</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of 13 14 Article V and Article IX of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe 15 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec-16 tion 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
