

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Accepting the Amendment of Section 1 of
Article III Rights of Members as recom-
mended by the Constitution Committee

Res. No. 112-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been presented with the final draft of the
2 proposed constitution; and
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed each proposed provision with comments
4 and explanations being made by the Constitution Committee; and
5 WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee has prepared certain alternative pro-
6 visions for consideration by the Papago Council; and
7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the alternative provision concerning
8 loss of membership under certain conditions and finds the same to be
9 appropriate;
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
11 accept the alternative provision proposed by the Constitution
12 Committee providing the: Membership in this Nation and all rights
13 deriving therefrom shall be lost if a person is convicted of the
14 criminal offenses of murder or voluntary manslaughter by any court
15 of competent jurisdiction.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
17 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
20 Article V and Article IX of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe
21 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
22 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec-
23 tion 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not
24 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the
25 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
