Direct the Papago Tribal Treasurer to Prepare a written analysis of options and/or alternatives for financing to purchase this land for San Lucy District and that all future reports of negotiations to purchase this land for San Lucy be in a written report.

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has by Resolution No. 63-83, 03-84 and 79-84
2 authorized negotiations for the purchase of certain land; towith
3 (originally Jordon property 234.4 acres and later the 297 acre
4 from Eleanor A. Logan); and


4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has not recieved sufficient information on the
5 progress of the negotiations:

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs
7 the Treasurer to provide the Council with a written analysis on
8 options and alternatives for financing the purchase of land for
9 the San Lucy District; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any further negotiations be reported to Council
10 in writing.


10 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
11 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
12 1338.0 for; 101.5 against; -0- not voting; -0- absent; pursuant to
13 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) of Article V
14 of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
15 ratified by the Papago Tribe on Decembêr 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
16 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
17 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
18 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
19 ment by the Papago Council.
