WHEREAS, the Papago Council has by Resolution No. 63-83, 03-84 and 79-84 authorized negotiations for the purchase of certain land; towith (originally Jordon property 234.4 acres and later the 297 acre from Eleanor A. Logan); and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has not recieved sufficient information on the progress of the negotiations:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs the Treasurer to provide the Council with a written analysis on options and alternatives for financing the purchase of land for the San Lucy District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any further negotiations be reported to Council in writing.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1338.0 for; 101.5 against; -0- not voting; -0- absent; pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
