## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Papago Tribal Council to allow the Sells District to negotiate the lease to operate the Indian Oasis Gas Station.

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of the lease between the Papago Tribe and Joseph Sestak, to operate the Indian Oasis Service Station; 2 and 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Sestak and Mr. Kuth-Le, a Tribal member negotiated an agreement 4 for transfer of Mr. Sestak's interest in the lease to Mr. Kuth-le pending the approval and signature of the Tribal Chairman; and 5 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council has expressed an interest in assuming 6 control over the operations of the service station; and 7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes it would be in the best interest of all 8 concerned to allow the Sells district to negotiate and enter into a lease for use of the service station. 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby authorizes 10 the Sells district to negotiate the lease to operate the Indian Oasis Gas Station and that the lease will from this time on be entered into 11 between the Sells District and the leasee; 12 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th 13 day of dune, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -O- agasint; -O- not voting; and -O- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) and Section 3 (e), and (h) of Articel V of the Constitution and By-laws of the 14 15 Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, 16 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
