

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Moratorium on New HBO Services

Res. No. 115-84


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on May 10, 1984 enacted into law the Cable
2 Communications Ordinance to regulate the installation, construction,
3 maintenance and operation of cable communications systems by
4 establishing licensing procedures and regulations; and
5 WHEREAS, The Cable Communications Ordinance does not cover television or radio
6 signals transmitted or received by microwave, satellite or other
7 non-cable features; and
8 WHEREAS, HBO a communications business providing television signals through
9 microwave frequencies has requested permission to provide its service
10 to San Xavier District households; and
11 WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has determined that a moratorium on
12 allowing HBO to operate within the San Xavier District is appropriate
13 until such time as the Cable Communication Ordinance is amended to
14 included non-cable communication systems;
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed the
16 San Xavier District's decision (Resolution not to permit) HBO to
17 provide its services to District households until such time as the
18 Cable Communications Ordinance is amended to regulate non-cable
19 communications systems and hereby approves of the same.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
21 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1379.0 for; -0- against; 61.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c), (f), and (h), (m)
24 of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
26 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
27 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
28 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
29 its enactment by the Papago Council.
