8	microwave frequencies has requested permission to provide its serv
	to San Xavier District households; and
9	WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has determined that a moratorium of
10	allowing HBO to operate within the San Xavier District is appropri
11	until such time as the Cable Communication Ordinance is amended to included non-cable communication systems;
	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed
12	San Xavier District's decision (Resolution not to permit) HBO to
13	provide its services to District households until such time as the
14	Cable Communications Ordinance is amended to regulate non-cable
15	communications systems and hereby approves of the same.

16	day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1379.0 for; -0- against; 61.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to

18	of Article V of the Contitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
19	the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 o
	the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject t review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
20	its enactmeny by the Papago Council.
