RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

San Xavier Mission Road Bridge

Res. No. 116-84

1 WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has by resolution No. 5-84-1 advised 2 the Papago Council of the restoration project disigned to construct and restore the Mission Road Bridge washed out by the torrential 3 flooding in early fall, 1983; and 4 WHEREAS, Federal laws have been enacted requiring cultural resources inventories 5 to identify and preserve historical and cultural archaeological resources associated with traditional or sacred values important to 6 Native people which are located on tribal or alloted lands; and 7 WHEREAS, The Arizona State Museum has applied for permission to carry out the 8 objectives of all applicable Archaeological and Historical Resource Protection and Preservation laws in conjunction with an existing 9 contract with the Arizona Department of Transportation; and 10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council reserves the right to review and possess all cultural resources excavated or recovered and to determine the dis-11 position of such including any human remains or cremations; and 12 WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has requested the Tribal Attorneys to 13 develop an ordinance for the protection and preservation of all archaeological and cultural resources which may be located on the 14 Papago Reservations but have agreed to allow the Mission Road bridge 15 to proceed with certain conditions; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed

17 Resolution No. 5-84-1 and approves of the stipulations required by
 18 the San Xavier District Council and directs all appropriate officials
 19 accordance with the terms and conditions set forth by the District
 20 Council.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1252.0 for; -0- against; 188.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c), (f), (h), and (1), (m), of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
