

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

San Xavier Mission Road Bridge

Res. No. 116-84

1 WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has by resolution No. 5-84-1 advised  
2 the Papago Council of the restoration project designed to construct  
3 and restore the Mission Road Bridge washed out by the torrential  
4 flooding in early fall, 1983; and

5 WHEREAS, Federal laws have been enacted requiring cultural resources inventories  
6 to identify and preserve historical and cultural archaeological  
7 resources associated with traditional or sacred values important to  
8 Native people which are located on tribal or allotted lands; and

9 WHEREAS, The Arizona State Museum has applied for permission to carry out the  
10 objectives of all applicable Archaeological and Historical Resource  
11 Protection and Preservation laws in conjunction with an existing  
12 contract with the Arizona Department of Transportation; and


13 WHEREAS, The Papago Council reserves the right to review and possess all  
14 cultural resources excavated or recovered and to determine the dis-  
15 position of such including any human remains or cremations; and

16 WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has requested the Tribal Attorneys to  
17 develop an ordinance for the protection and preservation of all  
18 archaeological and cultural resources which may be located on the  
19 Papago Reservations but have agreed to allow the Mission Road bridge  
20 to proceed with certain conditions;


21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed  
22 Resolution No. 5-84-1 and approves of the stipulations required by  
23 the San Xavier District Council and directs all appropriate officials  
24 to carry out the Mission Road repair and restoration project in  
25 accordance with the terms and conditions set forth by the District  
26 Council.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th  
28 day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
29 1252.0 for; -0- against; 188.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to  
30 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c), (f), (h), and  
31 (l), (m), of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
32 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of  
the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
