


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Requesting I.R.S. Determination under)
(Indian Tribal Governmental Tax Status)
(Act of 1982)

Res. No. 118-84


1 WHEREAS, the Indian Tribal Governmental Tax Status Act of 1982 (the "Act"),
2 P.L. 97-473, 96 Stat. 2608, 2611, 26 U.S.C. §7701 (a) (4) and § 7871
3 provides that Indian tribal governments shall for a period of two
4 years - from January 1, 1983, through December 31, 1984 - receive
5 certain tax benefits enjoyed by, and shall be treated as states
6 for certain purposes under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954; and
7 WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service did on May 7, 1984, finally publish
8 temporary regulations, 26 C.F.R. Part 305, determining that in
9 order to qualify as an Indian tribal government for purposes of
10 the Act its governing body must first receive a favorable ruling
11 from the Internal Revenue Service, and establishing procedural
12 rules to request such ruling; and
13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is the governing body of the Papago Tribe, Section
14 1, Article III of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ("Constitution")
15 , exercising essential governmental functions or defined in 26 CFR 305
16 7871-1 (d).
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
18 request a ruling from the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to
19 26 CFR § 305.7701-1 (a) that it be determined to be an Indian
20 tribal government for purposes of section 7701 (a) (40) and
21 section 7871 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman, Vice Chairman
23 Treasurer and attorneys of the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized and
24 directed on behalf of the Papago Council to submit and support this
25 ruling request in accordance with applicable revenue procedures.
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize
27 the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, attorneys, lobbyists
28 and other appropriate officers of the Papago Tribe to ask Congress
29 for a permanent extension of the Indian Tribal Governmental Tax
30 Status Act of 1982, and for the elimination of the additional
31 requirements imposed upon Indian tribal governments for tax
32 exempt bonds under section 7871 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code
of 1954.
The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
day of June, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent pursuant to
the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of
the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, rati-
fied by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
