RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Requesting I.R.S. Determination under) (Indian Tribal Goernmental Tax Status) (Act of 1982)

1	WHEREAS,	the Indian Tribal Governmental Tax Status Act of 1982 (the "Act"),
2		P.L. 97-473, 96 Stat. 2608, 2611, 26 U.S.C. §7701 (a) (4) and § 7871
3		provides that Indian tribal governments shall for a period of two
3		years - from January 1, 1983, through December 31, 1984 - receive
4		certain tax benefits enjoyed by, and shall be treated as states
5		for certain purposes under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Internal Revenue Service did on May 7, 1984, finally publish
0		temporary regulations, 26 C.F.R. Part 305, determining that in
7		order to qualify as an Indian tribal government for purposes of
8		the Act its governing body must first receive a favorable ruling
9		from the Internal Revenue Service, and establishing procedural
9		rules to request such ruling; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council is the governing body of the Papago Tribe, Section
11		1, Article III of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ("Constitution)
12		, exercising essential governmental functions or defined in 26 CFR 305
14		7871-1 (d). Managa and a Five of a Miles and Managa Color of All 43

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request a ruling from the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to 26 CFR § 305.7701-1 (a) that it be determined to be an Indian tribal government for purposes of section 7701 (a) (40) and section 7871 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman, Vice Chairman

Treasurer and attorneys of the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized and

directed on behalf of the Papago Council to submit and support this
ruling request in accordance with applicable revenue procedures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, attorneys, lobbyists and other appropriate officers of the Papago Tribe to ask Congress for a permanent extension of the Indian Tribal Governmental Tax Status Act of 1982, and for the elimination of the additional requirements imposed upon Indian tribal governments for tax exempt bonds under section 7871 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of June, 1984, at a meeging at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
